Board Dismissal for Failure to State a Claim under Board Law or Regulations,  
& Lack of Jurisdiction

On November 16, 2015, Petitioner Ashoor Alan Youhana filed an unfair labor practice complaint before the State Labor Relations Board (“Board”), pursuant to COMAR 14.32.05. In his complaint, Mr. Youhana alleges that he is entitled to payment earned during his time as an employee of Annapolis Car Center.

Petitioner’s complaint is deficient for two reasons. First, Petitioner fails to state a claim under the State Personnel and Pensions Article 3-306, or under corresponding Board regulations at COMAR 14.32.05, upon which relief may be appropriately granted. Second, Petitioner’s complaint fails to demonstrate that Petitioner is an employee of any unit of state government described in State Personnel & Pension Article §3-102(a)(1) through (2).

Accordingly, based on the discussion above, this complaint is dismissed.


